The following is a list of plants that will attract butterflies to your garden. Follow our basic outline below, and you will have a yard full of beautiful butterflies to enjoy.

Caterpillar Food – Host Plants

Butterfly: Food Source:

Monarch and Queen	Milkweed
Black Swallowtail	Parsley, Dill, Fennel and Rue
Giant Swallowtail	Citrus
Pipevine & Polydamas Swallowtail	Dutchman's Pipevine
Gulf Fritillary	Passionvine planted in sun
Zebra Longwing	Passionvine planted in shade
Orange-barred & Cloudless Sulphur	Cassias
Cassius Blue	Plumbago

Butterfly Food – Nectar Plants

Pentas (They love red)	Fire Bush
Lantana	Salvias
Coral Honeysuckle	Gaillardia
Butterfly Bush	Mexican Heather
Firecracker Plant	Mexican Petunia
Plumbago	Sapphire Showers

A Basic Outline For Designing Your Garden

- Choose a sunny location
- Include nectar plants to attract the butterflies
- Include host plants for the butterflies to lay their eggs
- Use large splashes of color like red and yellow
- Do not use pesticides in or near your butterfly garden
- Enjoy watching the butterflies!
